

Swanline's capital investment continues with new die-cutter

Swanline Print, the confidential trade supplier of specialist printed packaging and POS displays, has recently confirmed the purchase of a Klett Cobra Express high speed, automatic die-cutter.

The 'Best in Class' machine, can be configured to run with a Lead Edge Feeder or a Top Feed Unit and can produce 300+mm high batches or 1400mm or 1700mm high stacks. The Cobra Express can run 1mm carton grades up to 9mm Double Wall corrugated. The machine is capable of running at over 6000 feeds per hour.

Swanline's Nick Kirby commented, "The Klett Cobra Express adds a significant dimension to our capabilities. Not only does it represent outstanding performance and value, there are distinct benefits a machine of this speed can provide to our customers. At 1200mm x 1650mm, the machine also offers a size advantage over other machines in the market."

Alongside the Nuri SOL 2517 large format die-cutter installed in August 2009, the Klett further reinforces Swanline's dominance in this niche market.
